

Turn Your Firearm into Firearm Safety

Want to get your firearm out of your house?

You may have a teenager at home who is depressed and at risk for suicide.

You may have unwanted guns that were inherited or acquired unwillingly.

You may have excess guns that you no longer want.

You may feel that you can no longer safely use the gun.

You may have changed your mind about the desirability of owning a gun.

GETTING RID OF YOUR FIREARM – YOU HAVE OPTIONS:

1. **You can sell your firearm privately.** This option may require that you advertise that you have a gun in your house, risking theft. You may be able to sell it at a gun show, though this requires salesmanship.
2. **Sell it to a gun dealer.** This option (perhaps the most popular) requires that you accept the dealer's buying price.
3. **Take it to a wholesaler.** A wholesaler may destroy the frame and sell usable parts. This option requires that you find a wholesaler near you.
4. **Destroy it yourself.** This option requires that you have a torch or metal saw, and you know how to safely use it.
5. **Place in a bank safe deposit box.** This option is legal, but banks do not encourage it and many forbid it in their company policy.
6. **Give it to your attorney for storage.** This option requires that you have an attorney who will accept firearms.
7. **Find a buy-back program.** This option requires that such a program is currently in existence and available to you and you accept their buying price.
8. **Take it to your local police department.** The police will usually accept such firearms, but they do not have active turn-in programs and do not want to promote or advertise turning in your firearm to them.
9. **Take it to a pawnbroker.** This option requires that you accept the pawnbroker's price and terms. The gun's future is unpredictable.
10. **Donate it to us and receive a tax deduction!** We are a charitable 501(c)(3) organization that promotes firearm safety. We will give you a receipt for tax purposes. Turn your firearm into firearm safety! **Call 480/946-1971.**
NOTE: We will conduct a background check of your firearm's serial number.

- 1. Call 480/946-1971**
- 2. Bring your firearm to the Ben Avery Shooting Range, located on the north side of Carefree Highway (exit 223), just west of I-17.**
- 3. Receive a tax deduction for your contribution.**
