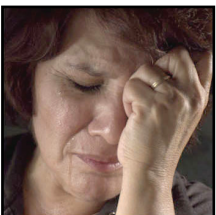


Turn your firearms into firearm safety!

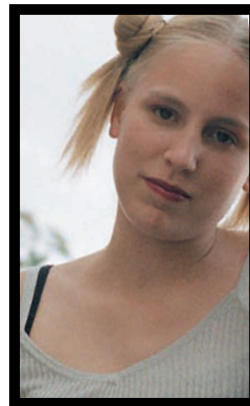
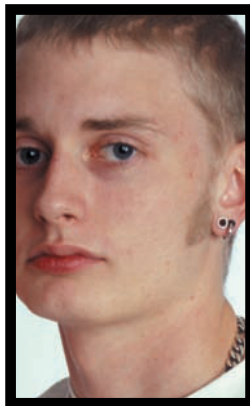

Removing a firearm from your home is as easy as 1-2-3!

1. Call the Arizona Firearm Injury Prevention Coalition at our Firearm Turn-In number: (480) 946-1971
2. Arrange for firearm pick-up.
3. Receive a tax deduction for your contribution. The Arizona Firearm Injury Prevention Coalition will turn the disposal value of the firearm into firearm safety.

Note: We will conduct a background check of your firearm's serial number.

You will receive a receipt for tax purposes following donation of your firearm to AFIPC.



Most suicides are committed with firearms

To permanently remove a firearm from your home, we recommend:

- **DONATE YOUR FIREARM TO THE ARIZONA FIREARM INJURY PREVENTION COALITION AND RECEIVE A TAX DEDUCTION!**

Though not recommended, you have other options for permanently removing a firearm from your home:

- **Sell or consign your firearm to a gun dealer.** You have to accept the dealer's terms.
- **Take your firearm to your local police department.** The police will usually accept such firearms, but most do not have an active turn-in program.
- **Find a buy-back program.** This requires finding a program available to you and accepting their buying price.
- **Sell your firearm privately.** This requires that you follow all federal and local laws and advertise that you have a gun in your home, risking theft.
- **Take your firearm to a pawnbroker.** You have to accept the pawnbroker's price and terms. The gun's future is unpredictable.
